- *Accommodation is available at racecourse for \$20.00 per box or \$15 per yard per night.
- * Local competitors from Central Hawke's Bay will NOT be allocated horse accommodation during the show.

The rider/handler must also wear two (2) RAS official armbands (one for each arm) when in the ring. Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest when outside the showing/jumping ring.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

*RAS HEIGHT CERTIFICATES/NOVICE PERFORMANCE CARDS MUST BE CARRIED AT ALL TIMES AND PRESENTED ON REQUEST. NO CARD – NO START – NO EXCEPTIONS.

MEASURING RULES (excerpts taken from RAS rules)

The Measuring Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (R.A.S.) will apply at this show.

Life Certificates

- 1. No Life Certificate will be issued until an animal has been suitably branded/microchipped.
- 2. Life Certificates may be issued to animals eight years old and over under the rules laid down by the R.A.S.
- 3. Life Certificates will not be issued on show days.

Annual Certificates

1. These Certificates will be valid from 1 August 2020 until 31st July 2021.

Measuring quidelines

- 1. Height certificates will only be accepted if the measurement has been made on a standard "Metcalfe" Measuring Stand and signed by the official measuring steward of the Association.
- 2. 0.5cm will be allowed for shoes.
- 3. All horses/ponies must be presented in a bridle with a bit for measuring.
