Ride Base

- Ride base is at **Twynham**, 156 Higgins Road, Howard RD2 Nelson
- All yards must conform to ESNZ standards
- All hold yards must conform to ESNZ standards and you will be advised where these can be set up
- All children 14 and under must be actively supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on ride base
- **STRICTLY No dogs allowed.**

Directions to Venue

If you have not been to a ride at Twynham before, try Google maps and search "Higgins Road, Howard 7072" or follow this link: <https://goo.gl/maps/dEFjyRQ3pnC2>

Heading North or South on State Highway 6 Turn off at "Kawatiri Junction" onto State Highway 63 over the bridge and head towards St Arnaud/Picton. Approx. 7kms on SHW63 on your left is Higgins Road (if you go over the bridge here you have gone too far!) Follow Higgins road for approx. 3kms and you will see ride base.

Coming from Picton (Approx. 150kms/2 hours) - Follow State Hwy 1 towards Blenheim, Turn Right at Spring Creek and follow Rapaura Road, Turn Left and Follow State Hwy 6 to Renwick, turn Right into Anglesea Street, turn Right onto State Hwy 63, Follow ST.HWY63 Through St Arnaud heading South West towards Murchison/West Coast, Higgins Road is on your Right immediately after crossing Harleys Rock Bridge (Buller River) Follow Higgins road for approx. 3kms and you will see ride base.

Definite Entries

- Definite entries close at 5pm on Friday 15 February and all fees must be paid by this date. Definite entries are now open at: <https://form.jotform.co/90131501649854>
- If you didn't nominate and still want to enter, you can do so, but as well as filling in a definite entry form, you still need to nominate also so we have a record of all details:
- Entries cannot be taken at the event.
- A late fee of \$30 per entry will apply to all entries and payments received after 5pm on Friday 15 February.
- The late entry fee and all other fees must be paid no later than Friday 22nd February for the combination to be eligible to compete at the event.

Health and Safety

- The venue opens at 12pm on Friday 1st March.
Due to logging operations access prior to this MUST be arranged with Phillip & Alison Higgins, they will arrange an escort vehicle to guide you onto the property. TXT ONLY

- While at the event, any person (rider, strapper or anyone else likely to be exercising a horse) must first come to the secretary's caravan and sign the waiver form.
- It will also be necessary for the rider to collect their rider pack before their horse can be ridden at the venue once these have arrived on base.
- At any time at the event the person riding the horse must wear the rider back number allocated to the horse. If this is outside of your competition then turn your rider bib inside out.

- Please keep well clear of the start/finish area and the track leading to the start/finish while exercising horses.
- Safety helmets and appropriate footwear must be worn at all times while riding.
- ESNZ GR Article 150.6 It is the responsibility of every individual at an equestrian event to ensure the health and safety of themselves and others.
- ESNZ GR Article 151.6. The use of cameras by riders while riding at a showground/competition venue (however such a camera is affixed, whether to the rider, protective headgear, head covering, or carriage) is prohibited, unless otherwise specifically agreed to by the ESNZ Technical Delegate officiating at the Event (in consultation with the President of the GJ, where appropriate). Such a decision will be completely at the discretion of the Technical Delegate/GJ President, and not subject to challenge. In the event that approval is given by the Technical Delegate/GJ President, an athlete's decision to wear a camera while competing will always be voluntary and at the athlete's own risk.

Yarding & Camping

- Camping is available at the venue, but is non-powered only.
- Portaloos will be available from Friday 1st March.
- All yards must comply with ESNZ Endurance regulations; either portable metal yards, or two strands of powered tape, with fixed corners (such as capped warratahs).
- Horses that may be arriving and competing on the one day are able to be tied to your float or truck but should not be left unattended.

Manure

- Please spread out all manure and hay on departure or put in shelter belts - DO NOT PUT AGAINST FENCES

Training Area

- Horses may be exercised on the training track that will be signposted. Please wear your bib inside out when riding.

Stallions

- Stallions will need to be contained in stallion yards that comply with ESNZ Endurance regulations.

Ice

- No Ice will be available at the ride base but can be purchased at Supermarkets and Service Stations in St Arnaud, & Murchison, Closest service station and store is St Arnaud 20kms away.

Water

- Water for both humans and horses will be on site from Friday. No shower facilities available.

Food and Drinks

- Catering will be onsite to cater for prize-giving, ground staff will be catered for by the OC.
- A coffee cart will be on site, purchases for all attendees including ground staff is at your own cost.

Farrier

- Any request for farrier work will be at riders own expense. Earl Paewai will be on base from Friday afternoon onwards. He will be located near the hold area and will remain on base throughout the event. Phone number for Earl is 0272303674.

Rubbish

- A rubbish bag will be in your rider pack, please use this for rubbish and tie the top and the OC will dispose of at end of event.

Prize Giving

- The Main Prize giving will be held on Saturday evening and a smaller prize giving on Sunday at the conclusion of the days events.
- If you cannot attend prize giving then please arrange for any prizes you may have won to be collected by someone else. Prizes will not be available for collection prior to prize giving.
- We have had great local support and would love all riders to join us for prize giving to recognise and acknowledge our generous sponsors.

Prize Giving Meal

- This will be held from 6.30pm on Saturday evening. BYO drinks.
- Cost of prize giving meal will be \$25.
- Sunday Free BBQ held in conjunction with Prize Giving.
- This is being catered by a local fundraising group in the small St Arnaud community, and will consist of Roast beef with jacket potato and salad selection followed by desert of brownie and berry coulis.
- If you wish to join us, then please order a meal ticket and pay for these with your Definite Entries.
- If you require prize giving meals and these have not been ordered via a competitor, email Jo at m.lankow@xtra.co with your meal ticket request.
- Meal tickets will be required to get your meal. Meal tickets will be in with your rider pack. Or if not ordered by a competitor, then collect from Jo.
- All meals need to be ordered with your definite entry. Late orders cannot be accepted.

Ride Secretary

- The Ride Secretary will be located in an on-site caravan.
- No logbooks will be available to collect until Prize Giving. If you have to leave earlier then please arrange for someone to collect your logbook or supply the ride secretary with a stamped, addressed envelope so the logbook can be posted to you.
- Back numbers can be collected from Midday Friday onwards regardless of which day you are riding.

Best Conditioned Judging

- The time for BC Judging will be announced each day once it is known which horses will be eligible.
- All horses eligible for BC must remain in the hold area until the commencement of BC judging unless advised otherwise by the Ground Jury or Chief Steward.

Waiver Declaration

- A Waiver declaration must be signed by all riders competing at the event. This can be signed at the event or you can download a copy, sign and hand it in when collecting your rider back number. If someone else is collecting your back number for you then it is essential you give them a signed copy of the waiver.
