Venue: Pukemarama Station (McKelvie's), 1597 Tangimoana Road (approximately 1 km past Rosina Road intersection)

Directions to Venue

Travelling from the South:

Turn left off SH1 onto Rosina Road (this is about 11 km before the main intersection at Sanson) – if you miss this turn, take the next left onto Rongotea Road.

At the intersection with Tangimoana Road, turn left (towards the coast) and the venue is about 1 km down on the right hand side.

If coming from Wairarapa then probably best to go through Bunnythorpe, onto Kairanga-Bunnythorpe Rd, right onto Rongotea Rd, then left onto Tangimoana Rd. Or stick to the main highways and fewer intersections to cross.

Travelling from the North:

Heading south on SH1 from Bulls, turn right immediately after the long bridge at the southern edge of Bulls over the Rangitikei River into Tangimoana Road.

Dinner and Prizegiving

Dinner tickets are \$10 per person and dinner will be a Chinese takeaways banquet, BYO plates, cutlery and chair.

Full refunds will be given on ride entry fees up to the start of pre-ride vetting for that class but no refunds after that time. A full refund will be given should the event be cancelled. Refunds will be transferred by internet banking after the event so we will need to know your account number for any refund.

FEI Clean Sport Fee

The FEI Clean Sport fee of \$30 is payable by all those in the CEI classes. This is in addition to the entry fee. This fee will be refunded in full to any entry that is withdrawn prior to the first horse inspection for the event entered in.

Any unregistered horse entered in a 40 km novice class requires a \$10 flexi-fee to be paid.

Please note that only 4 crew members (plus the rider) are allowed in the strapping area with each horse and crew members must be identified with the bib number (numbers and safety pins will be provided). Only 2 people per horse are allowed in the Vet Ring and one must be wearing the rider bib.

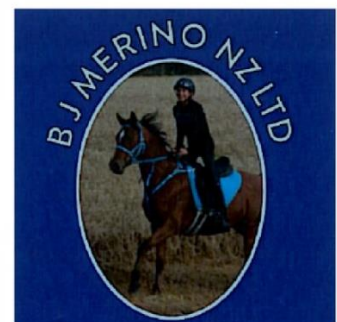
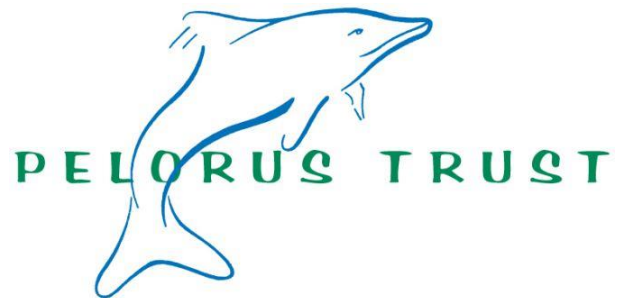
