

COVID 19 PROCEDURES FOR MARLBOROUGH ENDURANCE & TRAIL RIDING CLUB EVENTS – 2021-22

Rides can take place under Covid Alert Levels 1 and 2, as long as the following procedures are adhered to:

Ride base:

There is a limit of 100 riders per day, including support personal but not including Officials and Volunteers. Riders MUST be pre-entered, online, to ride at events. Payment must be prior, via internet banking as cash won't be accepted on the day. If you are bringing a support person with you, you must register them on the online form when you enter or email heidibulfin@hotmail.com to advise if not done at time of entry.

Please park so that you maintain at least 2m at all times from other people – allowing room for horses to be tied either side of floats and trucks. Horse pens are not allowed at this ride base.

Please scan in using our QR code which will be on the side of the caravan. You must do this sometime throughout the morning, preferably as soon as you arrive. Any support people you bring must also scan in so we have an accurate record of all who attend.

Please wear a mask when you come to the caravan to collect your back number – these are pre-allocated and there will be a list on the side of the caravan. Please only take your back number and not the coat hanger as well. There will be hand sanitiser for you to use before touching anything.

Please do not enter the caravan and please remain socially distanced from others.

The woolshed will be open and has two toilets inside – these are for using but please ensure you wash your hands thoroughly after using and try not to touch surfaces too much on your way in and out (doors will be open if weather allows). Please wear your mask in case you get close to others. Same applies with when you are filling your buckets of water from the ride base supply.

Vetting:

Please wear a mask for pre- and final vetting (over the line we don't expect it so just ensure you stand well back from the vet). This will be strictly enforced.

Prize Giving:

We won't be holding a prize giving under Level 2 but you can collect your certificate, logbook and ribbon from the Secretary when results are completed.
