

New Zealand Dressage Judges - Accreditation Points system- 6th October 2021 Revision 1

It is the responsibility of every DNZ Judge that they meet their obligations to remain accredited.

The following points system should assist all our Judges to maintain accreditation over a **2-year period** through the allocation of points according to the tasks in table below:

Task No.	Tasks are as follows:	Points:
1.	Judging an Official Graded DNZ Test including Young Dressage Horse, Graded Para Dressage and FEI Level Eventing Test:	
	More than 5 horses	20 points
	5 horses or less	10 points
	Judging a non-graded DNZ test, Intro test, Pony Club test, Eventing/horse trial test.	
	More than 5 horses	10 points
	5 horses or less	5 points
2A.	DNZ Educational Clinics: All judges must attend at least one "Approved" Official DNZ Judges Clinic once every 2 Years. (Judges are entitled to attend more Clinics throughout the two-Year accreditation process).	
	Nationally Approved DNZ Official Judges Clinic. (Approved by the JSC) Attend an approved "Official DNZ Judges Clinic" which must be presented by our National Educators (NZ FEI Listed Judges)	150 points.
2B.	Other Educational Clinics:	
	Attend an FEI Dressage Clinic/Seminar (registered and approved by the FEI) Held in NZ or Overseas	100 points
	Attend a Dressage Clinic in NZ presented by Overseas FEI judge/s and approved by the JSC	100 points.
	Attend an Overseas Official Dressage Clinic or Workshop with appropriate presenters	50 points
	Attend a Dressage Clinic for G-C Level Judges presented by Official DNZ Mentors/Educators	30 points
3.	Complete an Open Rule Book Test – Bi-annually	20 points.
4.	Acting in the role of Technical Delegate or Assistant Technical Delegate at any DNZ Event run under ESNZ Rules. (Note* It is compulsory for all A & B Level Judges to act as a TD or Assistant TD at least once every 2-years).	20 points
5.	Judging Out of area	5 points per event
6.	Judges highest class allowed	5 points per class
7.	Shadow Judge or Sit In at your highest Level	5 points per class
8.	Write or Sit in with an International Judge	10 points per class
9.	Write or sit in with a DNZ Judge Educator	5 points per class
10.	Compete at Advanced Medium or above, attaining 60% or more per test	5 points per class

Compulsory Requirements:

Minimum points per annum must total at least 100 points from Task 1.

Task 1. At least 60 of the points must come from Officially Graded DNZ Classes. The remainder of points can be made up from a combination of other non-graded judging experiences.

Task 2A. Attend an Approved Official Dressage Clinic at least once every 2 years.

Task 3. Complete the Open Rule Book Test every 2 years.

Minimum points to accumulate over a 2-year period:

-200 From Task 1.

-150 From Task 2.

-20 From Task 3

***Task 4.** For A & B level Judges - 20 points
