Riders in class 1, with horses entered in other classes, may request a yard for their other horse(s), inside the covered yards. However, those horses will then be subject to the class 1 security restrictions. Please indicate if this is a preferred option. Covered accommodation available for CCI 4*-L & CCI3*-L horses only.

Yard compulsory - no tying to trucks. Those coming by the day still need to pay for an outdoor yard. Covered yards are not available to riders not staying on the grounds, unless they have an NEC leased yard.

Special Conditions

1. Refer to Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MER) in FEI Rules and Regulations and ESNZ Eventing Rules for details of qualification criteria. Note qualification results are not required to be submitted with entry. It is the rider 's responsibility to ensure MERs are met at time of entry. All entries will be checked that MERs have been met from the online database. Any entries that have not met the required MER will **not** be accepted until MERs have been met as per MER deadlines.
2. Class 2-CCI3*-L open to all qualified combinations. The Picadilly trophy will be awarded to the highest placed combination where the Horse has achieved no more than two MERs at a level higher.
3. Class 3-CCI2*-L is open to qualified combinations where the Horse has achieved no more than two MERs at a level higher. The Mamaku Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class.
4. Class 5-CCN1*-L is open to qualified combinations where the Horse has achieved no more than two MERs at a level higher. The Thomson Trophy will be awarded to the winner of this class.
5. Silver Spurs Trophy - Inter-Island teams' competition.
6. Caseley Trophy - best presented horse over the entire competition – judged by a mystery judge.
7. Charlton Stud Prize - best performed mare over the entire competition.
8. NZPCA PC Award. Rosette and rug to highest placed Pony Club rider at the event. Pony Club riders must nominate and complete their PC information in their Equestrian Entries account to be eligible for this award. The winner will be calculated under the Swarbrick Scale. The NZPCA Rally Rule applies.
9. ESNZ Eventing Chair and Vice Chair Awards for: "Best Performed First-Time Competitor at the NZ3DE, Taupo" (CCN95-L and CCN105-L classes)".

National Series:

This is the final competition for all of the ESNZ Eventing Series.

Conditions of Entry:

1. The Organising Committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Eventing Rules Articles 610 & 611.
2. Classes will be run under all applicable FEI Rules and Regulations and where applicable the 2020 ESNZ Eventing Rules. ALL riders should consult the rules for information regarding qualifications, including Minimum Eligibility Requirements, qualifying periods and deadlines.
3. Excessive entries and balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Eventing Article 645. Maximum of 50 entries will be accepted into class 3 and class 5. Horses balloted into class 4 and class 6 respectively will be refunded the difference between entry fees.
4. All horses classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 are required to have either FEI Passport/Recognition Card or fully completed Official ESNZ Identification Papers (either ID Book or ID Page).
 - 4.1 Full ESNZ Equine Registration and Discipline Annual Start required for classes 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5
 - 4.2 Horses in class 6 can compete under ESNZ Casual Equine Registration and flexi start.
 - 4.3 Horses in class 7 & 8 can compete under ESNZ Casual Equine Registration.
 - 4.4 All horses entered in classes 1, 2 & 3 are required to be accommodated on the grounds for the duration of the event.
 - 4.5 All horses must be presented for the arrival inspection and will be subject to all relevant stable rules and announcements.
5. ALL riders in classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 must be Full Members of ESNZ. Riders in class 7 must be full or introductory members of ESNZ. Riders in class 8 must be Full Members, Introductory or Casual Members of ESNZ.
6. Competitors are reminded that ALL horses and riders in Classes 1, 2 & 3 must have a current 2021 registration with the FEI.
7. Entries online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz and payments made by direct credit to: Bank A/c 06-0513-0149329-00. By entering online, you are making an agreement with the Organising Committee and all fees are due even if you do not start at the event.
8. Late entries will be subject to a late entry fee of \$50. Late payments will be subject to a late payment fee of \$20 if funds are not received within two working days after close of entries.
9. All scratchings are to be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646.
 - 9.1 Requests for refunds will not be accepted after 28 May 2021. REFUNDS:
 - 9.2 Riders in FEI classes 1, 2, & 3 scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 11th May 2021) will be entitled to a 50%

refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.

- 9.3 Riders in national classes 4, 5, 6 & 7 scratching from the event 48 hours before the start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 11th May 2021) will be entitled to an 80% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.
10. All fees for combinations who do not gain the required qualification will be refunded in full, less a \$15 Admin Fee, by 31st May 2021.
11. Double Entries \$10, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 644.
12. All entries will be charged a non-refundable Administration Fee of \$15 per entry.
13. All fees and prize monies listed in this schedule include GST.
14. Accommodation to be completed online with your entry.
15. Acceptances will be notified by email as soon as practicable after close of entries, and will include further details on timetables etc.
16. Presentation of Prizes & Prize Money:
Unless otherwise notified in writing with entry, prize money will be paid in full (subject to IRD deductions), to the rider by Direct Credit to the bank account nominated on MY ACCOUNT in www.equestriantentries.co.nz by 20th June 2021 (subject to the results of any clean sport testing).

The Organising Committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with product of equal or greater value.

Individual prizes in excess of \$500 will have withholding tax deducted at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is completed prior to receiving the prize money, otherwise at the relevant no declaration rate of 45%. Individual circumstances do vary. Equestrian Entries will work with you to ensure the tax is appropriate for your circumstance, rules vary for Limited Liability, Partnerships and Trusts.

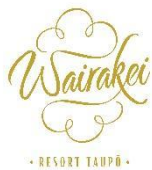

NATIONAL YOUNG EVENT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

This event will be run at Taupo in conjunction with the NZ Three Day Event Championships on Wednesday 12th May 2021.

Criteria for Qualification:

1. Horse to be four or five years old at date of final based on foaling date 1 August.
2. Rider to be 15 years or over.
3. Horse to be 15 hh or over and ridden in a snaffle bridle.
4. Horse to have completed an ESNZ Eventing Competition in the 2020/2021 season at CCN80 level or higher.

Format of the Competition:

Each of the 4 tests has an individual judge. The judges look for an athletic, loose moving horse with a promising jumping technique which, with correct training, should make a good event horse. Martingales and boots are optional but NO time will be allowed for change of tack between sections.

1. Simple dressage test. Emphasis on paces and trainability 35%.
2. Jumping. Approx 10 fences, mix of Show jumps & Cross-Country fences 35%.
(4 year olds 90cm-1m, 5 year olds 1m -1.10m)
3. Gallop to be suitable for XC 15%.
4. Movement, Conformation and Suitability of Type 15%.

At the end of this judging the top 5 horses on points will compete in front of all the judges who will decide the final placings. Each judge will place the horses as he/ she thinks and the rankings from all 4 judges will then be added, with the winner being the horse with the lowest total score.

Points will not carry through, although in the event of a tie, points from the qualifying round will decide the winner. Horses will be asked to complete a 2-minute freestyle dressage display followed by 6 jumps in the indoor arena.

Special awards

- Best Performed Mare receives a presentation rug and rosette.
- Best Performed 4 year old will receive a presentation rug.
- Best Registered Thoroughbred will receive a rug and rosette.
