## ESNZ Membership:

- 80km Open or Novice – Rider must be a Full member of ESNZ, member of an ESNZ affiliated Endurance club and Horse must be registered with applicable Endurance discipline start.
- 40km Intermediate or Novice - Rider must be an Introductory or Full member of ESNZ as well as a member of an ESNZ affiliated Endurance club. Horses can be registered with Endurance Start (if you want kms and results to be recorded) or Unregistered horses pay a \$10 flexi start fee per competition.
- 24km/16km Intro Endurance - Rider can be an Introductory, Full or unregistered. Unregistered riders must pay an additional ESNZ day membership fee of \$15.

(we do offer refunds if you can't attend but please advise us so we know)

No smoking on base or on any parts of the tracks. Please scatter your horse manure and take home any litter.  
No dogs on base or on any parts of the tracks, at all times.

- This is a ride suitable for all levels of experience and horse fitness – mixture of flat and rolling hill vineyard.
- Suitable barefoot horses
- Ribbons and certificates for all place getters and qualifiers
- Special awards for Novice and Intro Endurance – for quickest “lag time” between the finish line and vet gate (more info to follow)

## Ride base directions

- 671 Seaview Road Seddon
- Turn off SH1 at Seddon (Goulter Street, Wakefield Street then Seaview Road if coming from North, Wakefield Street then Seaview Road if coming from South – take care with turn off SH1), following the Yealands winery signs. Continue past Yealands winery on Seaview Road and ride base is approx. 1.4km from winery, on next the left of the sharp corner and will be signed
- There is water at ride base and on the ride. Camping available – Saturday and Sunday nights

## COVID-19

Although we should still be in Level 1, we will still have Covid-19 precautions in place. There will be a tracing code on the caravan door which you can use your tracer app to sign in. Please make sure you have logged any support people coming with you through our online entries and please limit these. There will be hand sanitiser available.
