ESNZ Membership:

Open, Intermediate, Junior CTR - Rider must be an Introductory or Full member of ESNZ as well as a member of an ESNZ affiliated Endurance club. Horses can be registered with Endurance Start (if you want kms and results to be recorded) or Unregistered horses pay a \$10 flexi start fee per competition.

Novice CTR - Rider can be an Introductory, Full or unregistered. Unregistered riders must pay an additional ESNZ day membership fee of \$15

Overnight camping available by appointment so please advise if you require this. Water will be available for horses at the ride base but it is recommended that you bring water for yourself.

No smoking on base or on any parts of the tracks. Please take home your horse manure and any litter.

- Ribbons and certificates for all place getters and qualifiers

Ride base directions

- Approx 10km from Renwick on SH63, or 14km from Wairau Valley, on the river side of the highway and almost opposite the Ditchling sign. There is a small fish and game sign at the start of the road. Turn off the highway and follow the gravel drive, and then turn right and go through the large vineyard gates, that will be signed, you will eventually get to the ride base paddock which is tucked in under the terrace hill.

COVID-19

Although we will be in Level 1, we will still have Covid-19 precautions in place. There will be a tracing code on the caravan door which you can use your tracer app to sign in. Please make sure you have logged any support people coming with you through our online entries and please limit these. There will be hand sanitiser available.
