Refund Rule Scratchings – refunds less 20% if notified by 9am Thursday 21st February 2019.
Thereafter no refunds for any reason. No refunds on late entries.

Special Conditions

- a) To start all riders must have current ESNZ membership. Casual Membership of \$10 is available for riders in classes 7 & 8.
- b) Unregistered horses in classes 4 to 8 may start on a casual ESNZ Equine Registration of \$5 per horse.
- c) Unregistered horses, or horses with no eventing discipline start, may start in classes 4 to 6 with an Eventing Flexi Start of \$15 per horse.
- d) Amateur Classes
 - i. Age - From the first day of the season which you reach 22 years
 - ii. May NOT have been part of Senior Representative Team (TranTasman/Oceania, WEG, Olympics)
 - iii. May NOT have gained a MER at CCN4*-S (3* pre Jan 2019) in previous 5 seasons or CCN3*-S (2* pre Jan 2019) in previous 3 seasons
- f) No unauthorised motorbikes on the grounds
- g) Food and farrier available on grounds
- h) No person under the age of 18 may consume alcohol on the Rotorua A&P Association grounds.
- i) Dogs to be on a lead at all times. No dogs allowed on Ngati Whakaue Land. Fine/Elimination if these rules not adhered to.
- ii) Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money, and to substitute prize money with goods to the value of, at their discretion – Article 611
- k) No Non competition horses on the grounds at any time
- l) **As a condition of entry all local BOP riders must supply a helper prior to or during the event.**
- m) All classes part of ESNZ Eventing National Series Competitions.
- n) All classes run under ESNZ Eventing Rules
- o) **Article 610 – DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**
